The Big Local has awarded £10,000 for community projects at its first two Dragons' Den evenings. The good news is that we have more money set aside for our third Den coming up on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November. From a total pot of £6k anyone with an idea that benefits Radstock or Westfield can apply to win up

to £500 on the night. 20 projects have been funded by Dragons' Den so far including a new tent for Radstock Scouts to use at their summer jamboree and song sheets for the Westfield Ladies Choir. Big Local is also giving awards that contribute to larger projects such as helping children go on an outward bound adventure which cost more than £500. We are also looking to support ideas which may need some initial funding to get the ball rolling, such as for commissioning research. ## Cash for Young People

In the Big Local Plan we have responded to calls to support the young people of Radstock and Westfield by ear-marking £12,000 over three years. Big Local want young people to be at the centre of how this money is used. To get this going we arranged a summer BBQ so that everybody could have their say in between mouthfuls.

In line with our general approach we will be working with other key partners in the community and both the Radstock Youth Hub

and Radical are partnering this strand in our Plan. The budget for this year is £4,000 and ideas so far include a skate ramp, a meeting shelter and a fire pit. We are welcoming ideas and more young people at the next meeting which will be at Radical youth club, Church Tea Rooms, 2<sup>nd</sup> October. The next stage will be to formalise the process for making final decisions on how the money will be spent. We would welcome help and involvement from other groups such as Duke of Edinburgh, Scouts, Guides, Cadets, sports clubs, gaming clubs. This money is ready to spend right now.
