Community Training Kitchen and Healthy Living Centre Options:



We will soon be investing in the delivery of a youth programme which meets specific needs as identified by the young people in the community. In order to do this, we will be putting the contract out to tender. We have sent a request for expressions of interest to over 15 organisations who work with young

Therefore, we may be in contact with you before we meet in November as a Partnership member for you to consider an increase to the allocated budget (see table of current plan allocation of spend).


The Youth programme will address the causes of and solutions to bullying; Improving mental health in young people, including body image and exam stress; and addressing issues around alcohol and drug use.

calendar month. We will have a direct link to our Facebook page via the online Journal article.


